

# Help Keep Zika Out of Baltimore




## Keep mosquitoes **outside**

Keep screens on all windows.

Use air conditioning when possible.

Repair holes in screens.

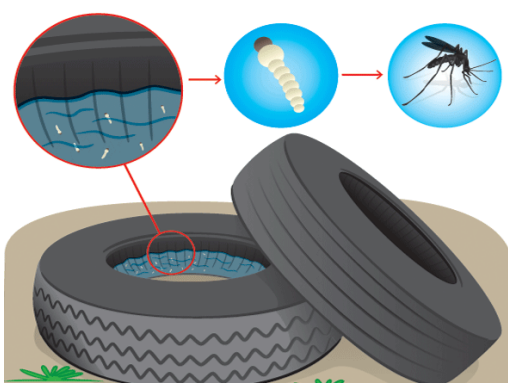
Keep doors and windows shut if they don't have screens.



## Stop mosquitoes from **breeding**

Mosquitoes lay eggs in and near standing water found in:

- Buckets
- Roof gutters
- Old tires
- Coolers
- Toys
- Trash
- Birdbaths and outdoor ponds
- Trash containers, and recycling bins



Make sure these objects do not become breeding sites for mosquitoes.

- Remove them or put them inside
- Cover them
- Empty once a week
- Treat with larvicide tablets

If you see standing water in your neighborhood, eliminate if possible or call 311 to report it.

Mosquitoes only need the amount of water in a bottle cap to breed.
