  - Controlled by DOP; How can we support those doing urban agriculture and keep space in certain zip codes?
- Lack of land security
- Sustainability
- Lack of support

#### **Summary of Meetings**

- Finances Lack of adequate funding and revenues
- Education Lack of community education
- Youth Desire to educate youth and work with schools
- Policy Lack of policies that support UA and farmers
- Community Lack of community support & concerns of safety
- Environment Soil testing, soil remediation, and environmental sustainability

#### **Literature Review**

- A food system solely reliant on UA cannot address food insecurity
- Must be met with intentional health communication and education through marketing

#### What's Missing?

- Strong distribution networks
- Innovative marketing
- · Health education
- Financial and policy support
  - Lack of understanding at policy level of impact made by farms
