Purpose of our study:

We have people who help us with our care.

Who am I?

My name is Catherine Clair, and I am a PhD student at the Johns Hopkins School of Public Health in Baltimore, MD. As part of my degree program, I am doing a research dissertation (final project).

What am I studying?

We may have family, friends, and neighbors, who form one network. And at the same time, we may have formal health care providers who form another network of care. I believe these two care networks are integrated and operating together as we care for our older loved ones.

Why am I looking at care networks?

These care networks, and their interaction, may be related to our use of acute health services, such as urgent care and the Emergency Room. If we better understand care networks, we can understand how to improve people's health and avoid unnecessary visits.

Who can participate in this study?

I am doing a survey with older adults (65 years or older) with Type 2 diabetes in Maryland.

What does participating involve?

First, interested people can call the study number (443-885-0842). We would determine if the person is eligible. If eligible, then I would read the consent to them, and they would let me know if they consent to participate.

We would schedule a time to complete the survey together – whenever works in the person's schedule. The session should take 1-2 hours and can be done over the phone, by Zoom, or in-person, either at home or on the Baltimore school campus – entirely up to the person!

The survey has a few parts: The first part is focused on demographic characteristics (i.e., age, gender, race) and your health. The second and third parts ask about who is involved in your health care, which could include friends, family, and formal health care professionals.

As a "thank you" for their participation, participants will receive a \$30 Target or Walmart gift card and a copy of the consent form in the mail.
