# Baltimore Metropolitan Diabetes Regional Partnership

Part of a grant awarded through HCRC partnerships throughout MD.

#### **Focus**

Diabetes self-management and education; prevention Increase capacity of referrals

#### **Initiatives and Goals**

Have more people involved in diabetes self-management and education, especially Medicare patients MC covers diabetes education - provide education BEFORE diagnosis - only 5% of beneficiaries use this benefit, goal to increase to 25%

More people enrolled in programs within communities served.

Providing wraparound services to individuals with diabetes and prediabetes

Reduce amputations and other microvascular complications

#### **Activities**

#### Food

- Partner with urban farmers to send patients who need fresh produce to the farms.
- Food pantry @ Diabetes Center (UMD)
- Faith-based organizations distribute food within communities, integrate blood pressure screenings. Add diabetes screening to the mix?

#### **Education**

- Marketing programs consumers need to know that our programs exist
- Tabling at outreach events, following up after
- Improve awareness pts don't hear about their risk before diabetes dx.
