

# TYPES OF TESTING

## **A—Anonymous-HIV**

Individual being tested does not give his/her name. An identifying number is assigned at the time of testing which is used as signature on the informed consent form.

## **C—Confidential-HIV (Recommended)**

Utilizes an individual's name, date of birth, last four digits of social security number, other ethnicity and other identifying information for medical record keeping, but information is NOT disclosed to anyone without client's written permission.

Clients testing positive would benefit from receiving managed care services.

## **A/C—Anonymous & Confidential**

Both are offered

## **S - Syphilis (Recommended)**

Confidential testing offered to detect possible co-infection with HIV.

Clients may receive free treatment at various sites if they test positive.

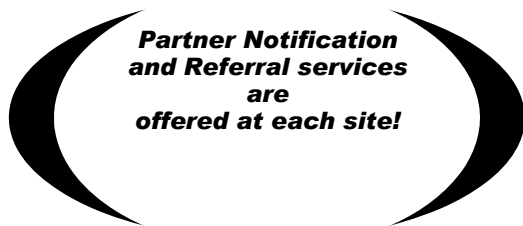
