

## *Accountable Health Communities Intern*

The Baltimore City Health Department is seeking Accountable Health Communities Interns. This position will be 20-40 hours a week, Monday through Friday. We are looking to fill these positions immediately beginning in June 2019, with opportunity to continue in the fall.

Primarily, interns will be placed in various hospital sites across the city and will screen patients for social needs using the Accountable Health Communities screening tool. Interns will also complete administrative work at the Baltimore City Health Department as needed. This is an unpaid position, but is a perfect opportunity for a student seeking direct patient interaction, graduation credit, volunteer hours, or practicum requirements.

### *Candidate Requirements*

- Candidates must be 18 years or older.
- Candidates must be currently pursuing associates, undergraduate, or graduate level studies.
- Candidates must be able to meet all hospital volunteer requirements including but not limited to a recent tuberculosis test and up-to-date immunizations.
- Candidates may need to complete a background check and medical clearance.
- Candidates must be able to attend all hospital volunteer training events and complete HIPPA and other trainings as needed.

### *Candidate Desirables*

- Previous hospital/clinical patient interaction experience strongly preferred.
- Knowledge of social determinants of health, excellent communication and organization skills, professionalism in the hospital setting, adaptable
- Attention to detail, eager to learn and engage, ability to think broadly
